

## Domaine des Deux Arcs, Anjou Rouge 2016 Anjou Rouge, Loire Valley, France

### HISTORY

The Domaine des Deux Arcs is a 5<sup>th</sup> generation family estate owned and operated by Jean-Marie Gazeau in Martigne-Briand, in the heart of the Anjou region since 1992. It's name refers to a sketch representing the Tigné-Noyant road where the plain separates the vineyard in two. To date, the estate has 48 hectares of vineyards on quality terroirs (Coteaux du Layon, Anjou Villages) and Prestige (Bonnezeaux, Savennières).

### GRAPES, AREA & VINIFICATION

100% Cabernet Franc. 20 days skin maceration and micro-oxygenation to refine the structure.

### TASTING NOTES

Deep red color. The nose shows aromas of red and black fruits with violet. The mouth is well rounded with good fruit.

A very food friendly wine for everyday meals, red meat and light cheeses.
