HISTORY

Located in Volnay, five kilometers south of Beaune, Domaine Pierre Glantenay et Fils operates twenty acres of vineyards in the appellations of : *Volnay, Pommard, Meursault, Monthélie and Chambolle-Musigny*. Our estate was launched in the 16th century and was passed from generation to generation until siblings Guillaume and Fanny Glantenay took over the Domaine from their father Pierre Glantenay. Monthélie is situated between Volnay and Meursault, looking out at the first hills of the Côte de Beaune.

GRAPES, AREA & VINIFICATION

100% Chardonnay. Facing south and south-east, the vineyards of Monthélie lie on pebbly Bathonien limestone overlain by red clay and marl. Sustainable vineyard practices. Grapes are managed, monitored, harvested and sorted all by hand

TASTING NOTES

With its handsome golden highlights, white Monthélie is a close cousin to Meursault. Its lemony aromas blend with notes of white flowers, Reinette apple, and fresh hazelnut. In the mouth, its mellow taste is backed by the degree of acidity which is essential in great white wines.

Pairs well with prawns or fish tajines whose multiplicity of textures finds an echo in the liveliness and suppleness of the wine.
For cheese: Roquefort, Époisses or Livarot.
