HISTORY

Our Château is located in St. Genies de Comolas, in the Rhône Valley, and extends 70ha. For nearly 40 years, we have updated our production process without foregoing the traditions which are not only dear to us, also a true passion. Splendid plots, adorned by rolled pebbles once carried by the Rhône River, allows noble grapes such as Syrah, Grenache, Clairette and Mourvèdre to blossom.

GRAPES, AREA & VINIFICATION

50% Grenache, 30% Syrah, 20% Carignan. Soil is clay and chalk covered with rolled pebbles. Hand harvest with traditional vinification. Vatting from 15 to 21 days in thermo regulated tanks. Aged in oak barrels for 4 months.

TASTING NOTES

This wine has a lovely deep purple color. On the nose, it reveals an intense bouquet of black and red fruits. On the palate, round tannins and fruit, full bodied.

Pairs well with grilled meats and cheese.
